

Synopsis: Living on the fringes of Israeli society, troubled boys must band together to save the shelter for at-risk youth that has kept them off the streets. For generations, altruistic surrogate mother, Margalit (Tiki Dayan), provided loving refuge to victims of neglect and violence in a shabby house on Tel Aviv's outskirts. When tragedy strikes, it's up to the right-hand man Jackie (Roy Assaf) to keep the home from corrupt property developers, and assuage a social worker's scrutiny. With tough love from "big brother" Jackie, the young men must now be accountable for their own lives, and save their refuge from a dire fate. Inspired by a true story, this compassionate drama gives voice to those on the periphery, often unnoticed and uncared for.





Director's Biography: Erez Tadmor wes born in Israel in 1974. He is a writer and director from Tel-Aviv, Israel. He graduated from Camera Obscurs Film School Tel Aviv. His first short *Moosh* won over then 40 international film festivals awards including *World fest in Houston*, Palm springs and many more.
