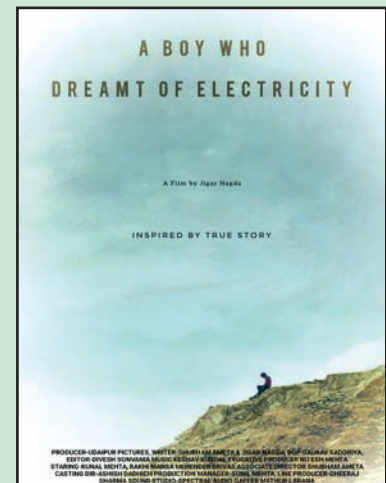
A boy who dreamt of electricity

Synopsis : Bheru, 21, is from a tribal community and lives in an interior hilly village in Western Rajasthan with his father and mother, who work as farm labourers for the village Sarpanch. Will Bheru be able to bring electricity to his house after all his efforts? It's a story about hope and bringing change.

He has spent the last ten years working in the Indian film industry, as an assistant director with prominent Indian filmmakers such as Anurag Kashyap, Onir, and Manish Gupta.
