**Synopsis**: Sandra, Samuel, and their visually impaired son Daniel have been living in a remote mountain location for the past year. When Samuel is found dead outside the house, an investigation is launched for his suspicious death. Amidst uncertainty, Sandra is indicted: was it a suicide or homicide? Daniel attends his mother's trial a year later, discovering a veritable dissection of his parents' relationship. He thus faces a moral dilemma as the sole witness.





**Director's Biography:** Justine Triet graduated from the Ecole nationale supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris. Her early works include *Sur place* (2007), which was filmed during student protests, and *Solferino* (2009) filmed during presidential election, questions the role of the individual within a group. Her first medium-length fiction film won numerous awards at festivals in France and abroad. Her first feature, *Age of Panic*, premiered at Acid in Cannes in 2013 and received a César nomination in 2014 for the best feature film. Her second feature, *In Bed with Victoria*, was the opening film at the critics week in Cannes in 2016. In 2019, her third feature, *Sybil*, was played in the festival's main competition. Her Anatomy of a Fall won the Palme d'Or at Cannes in 2023.
