Director's Biography: Nuri Bilge Ceylan was born in 1959, in Istanbul. Following his graduation from Bosphorus University, he spent two years studying filmmaking at Istanbul's Mimar Sinan University. He directed the short film *Koza*, which was a competitive entry at the Cannes Film Festival, in 1995. At the 1998 Berlin Film Festival, *Kasaba*, his first feature film, took up the Caligari Prize. He also directed *Mayis Sikintisi* (Clouds of May), which was a nominee at the Berlin Film Festival competition film (2000). His film Uzak (Distant) won the Grand Prix and Best Actor honors at Cannes in 2003.
