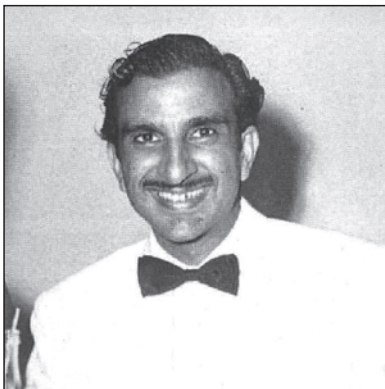

Synopsis : A newspaper editor Shrivastav gets life threatening calls when he tries to expose a powerful person he in tern informs Inspector Shekhar. But before Shekhar reaches office, Shrivastav gets killed. He notices a suspect outside the office and tries to trace the suspect in Rekha's car, who mistakes him as a thief. A pickpocket who has seen the murder, identifies a person called Sher Singh who was one of the gang members. Shekhar finds that Rekha is the daughter of chief of police and they clear the misunderstandings between them and fall in love.
